



One workspace. Two signal languages.

LSCT Nexus connects Arabic and English Telegram text signals with a controlled MetaTrader 5 workflow. Version 3.14.0rc1 - release candidate; launch copy pending acceptance.

Website hero - draft for release review

For evaluation and controlled acceptance. This candidate has not completed actual Telegram-to-broker or independent Windows installation acceptance. It is not an available-for-sale or LIVE-qualified product announcement.

Turn signal messages into a structured trading workflow.

Select your sources. Set your limits. Review the interpretation, execution records and protection settings in one English workspace. LSCT Nexus is designed to handle Arabic and English signals without changing your account's execution rules.

What the candidate provides

- Arabic and English text interpretation for buy/sell, explicit price, zone and immediate-entry signals, with stop-loss and indexed targets.
- Selectable Telegram sources and exact broker symbols, whole-setup risk limits and aggregate exposure checks.
- Planned entry legs, target allocation, broker tick/volume rounding and protection rules tied to the owned setup.
- An English Windows launcher, browser onboarding, operating controls, source analysis and branded Excel export.

A clearer instruction boundary

Waiting, invalidation, conflicting prohibitions and unsupported prose require review. A valid-looking price pattern is not permission to trade. New-message, reply and execution records help explain the decision; records are evidence to inspect, not a performance guarantee.



Monthly plans with a common safety base

Each license binds one fixed MT5 trading account and one execution session. Source and symbol quotas set the service level; basic protection is available across plans.

Proposed customer plan structure

A source means a channel, group or incoming personal chat within one Telegram login. It does not mean an additional Telegram phone account. No customer lifetime subscription is offered. Final prices, payment terms and availability require owner approval before publication.

Protection is a workflow, not a return promise

- Whole-setup and total-open-risk checks apply even when fixed lots are selected. Unmeasurable exposure can block new entries.
- Break-even can be triggered by a source instruction, price distance or progress toward TP1. Individual or worst-entry group qualification is configurable.
- Per-target trailing begins after confirmed protection and cannot deliberately move stops backwards. Milestones can move stops to earlier target levels.
- Start is separate from connection. Pause and Emergency block new entries; they do not declare the account flat.

Scope of Pro and trial

Pro has the manual-operation entitlement for the supported controlled tools. The browser manual flow is preview-only; automatic adoption of existing MT5 positions is disabled. Do not advertise a complete manual-trade manager. An eligible trial is limited by the owner's service; it is not an unconditional new trial on every device.



Campaign drafts and customer questions

Three short English drafts for future review. Retain the release-candidate qualifier until the owner has documented acceptance and approved publication.

Ad 1 - bilingual signals

Arabic signals. English signals. One structured workspace. LSCT Nexus brings source selection, MT5 setup planning and reviewable execution decisions together. Explore the release candidate - launch pending acceptance.

Ad 2 - control before execution

Your sources, symbols and risk limits - defined before the next signal. Preview the plan, then start the selected trading mode deliberately. LSCT Nexus 3.14.0rc1 is an evaluation candidate; actual execution acceptance is still outstanding.

Ad 3 - grow the service, retain protection

Choose Core, Scale or Pro for the sources and symbols you need. Every plan keeps the basic protection controls and one fixed trading account per license. Monthly service only. Release-candidate preview; commercial availability is not announced.

FAQ - answer these accurately

- Does it guarantee profits or correct every message? No. Ambiguous or unsupported instructions require review. Execution, slippage and trading losses remain possible.
- Does it support LIVE? The candidate includes an explicit LIVE path with exact-account confirmation and a separate Start. That capability is not LIVE qualification; actual DEMO acceptance must come first.
- Can it execute screenshots or an ambiguous approval? Image/OCR execution and browser ambiguity-approval execution are not enabled.
- Can I control it from a phone? The default workspace is local. Remote access requires separately deployed private HTTPS access and matching origin configuration.
- What remains before release? An owner HTTPS licensing service, publisher signing and an independent permitted Windows acceptance environment are not yet available. No final installation or real Telegram/MT5 test is claimed.
